What is the Chairs Coordinating Committee?

As in planning a multi-course meal, each menu item selected must complement the courses surrounding it. The *Chairs Coordinating Committee (CCC)* represents an effort to address transportation challenges on a regional, long range basis. Issues such as personal mobility, access to jobs, goods movement, emergency evacuation, and growth management are considered by the **CCC**, which is made up of the chairs from the six member *Metropolitan Planning Organizations* and administrative organizations representing the eight counties shown on the regional map. In addition, the Region's **FDOT** District Secretaries, the Turnpike and the *Regional Planning Councils* are represented on the **CCC** in a non-voting capacity. The **CCC** makes plans based on growth trends for the West Central Florida region. Quarterly, the **CCC** meets to develop regional solutions to transportation problems and ensure a consistent planning approach among the six **MPOs**. The **CCC** is responsible for planning the following menu items:



- ~ Regional Long Range Transportation Plan
- ~ Regional Congestion Management System
- ~ Air Quality Management Planning Process
- ~ Regional Multi-Use Trails Element
- ~ Regional Data Sharing and Mapping
- ~ Regional Public Involvement Program
- ~ Major Investment Studies Coordination
